

## **Types of Import Market Access Request**














- FSA provided 2 auditors to assist the UK Office
- Drafting of Audit Report underway


#### India

Request to review the import control on aquaculture products (Prawns/Shrimps)

- Response provided to a UK Technical
   Questionnaire; initial responses lack detail and further clarifications will be required.
- Anticipated that an in-country verification audit will be required, possibly in January 2023.
- UK Office have requested FSA provide an auditor to assist in-country.
